Arabian Peninsula

About

Despite its regional and global significance, the Arabian Peninsula has played a tangential role in the study of the modern Middle East. Its states and their populations often factor in simply by way of explaining the problem of the “rentier state,” energy security, and since 11 September 2001, the rise of Salafi/Wahhabi Islam and its alleged relation to global terrorism. *Jadaliyya's* Arabian Peninsula Page seeks to further the debates on the region and its eighty million inhabitants from a myopic focus on statistics, conjecture, and religious violence to one on people and communities, everyday hardships and popular struggles, culture and politics. It will bring together scholars, writers, artists, bloggers, journalists, and activists who work on or live in Bahrain, Kuwait, Qatar, Oman, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, and Yemen.

Jadaliyya invites analytical articles, short essays, book/film reviews, photo/video essays, literary pieces, interviews, and reports that further our understanding of the region's history, culture, literature, politics, and society. We accept 500 to 2500-word long submissions in both Arabic and English. The goal is to provide an open and collaborative space for the production of knowledge on a region that has largely escaped critical engagement.

Review Process:

All submissions are reviewed within one week of being received by *Jadaliyya's* Arabian Peninsula editorial committee and, once accepted, undergo a process of collaborative editing with the author.

Submission Guidelines:

Please ensure the following is included with your submission:

- An image related to the content of the post. The size must be 300 by 400 pixels, and a specific source must be included.
- Comma-separated tags at the bottom of the post based on what the post is about: e.g., Egypt, revolution, protests, army.
- Hyperlink words in the article if they refer to links on the internet. We encourage hyperlinks. Please avoid footnotes and embed them as hyperlinks if possible.
- Sign and email the copyright Release Form (download [here](#)).

Submissions Checklist

- ✓ Submit an image related to the content of the post.
- ✓ Hyperlink words in your article if they refer to links on the internet.
- ✓ Select 2-3 quotes from your post.
- ✓ Include comma-separated tags based on what your post is about.
